Tycko & Zavareei LLP is pleased to announce that it is accepting applications for the **2023–2025 Tycko & Zavareei LLP Public Interest Fellowship** (the “Fellowship”). The Fellowship, now in its 12th year, is designed for recent law school graduates. The Firm will be conducting interviews of current 3L law students and current law clerks beginning in late September of 2022.

The Fellowship will run for approximately two years, beginning in the fall of 2023. The firm’s primary office is in Washington, DC, with secondary offices in Oakland, California and Los Angeles, California. For this Fellowship term, the Firm will be hiring two Fellows—one based in Washington, DC and one based in Oakland, CA.

The Fellowship is intended for individuals with a demonstrated commitment to a career in public interest law. The Fellows will be full-time employees of the Firm for the duration of the Fellowship. During that time, the Fellows will each have the opportunity to spend three months working directly for a public interest organization based in Washington, DC or California. Past Fellows have worked with the following well-established, highly respected non-profits:

- **Human Rights First** (www.humanrightsfirst.org), which advocates on behalf of human rights in the United States and around the world.
- **The National Women’s Law Center** (www.nwlc.org), which fights for women’s rights in employment, education, healthcare and other areas.
- **Bread for the City** (www.breadforthecity.org), which provides vulnerable residents of Washington, D.C. with comprehensive services, including legal assistance.
- **National Consumer Law Center** (www.nclc.org), which works for consumer justice and economic security for low-income and other disadvantaged people, including older adults.
- **Public Justice** (www.publicjustice.net), which pursues high impact lawsuits to combat social and economic injustice, protect the Earth’s sustainability, promote equitable food systems, and challenge predatory corporate conduct and government abuses.
- **Tzedek DC** (www.tzedekdc.org), whose mission is to “safeguard the legal rights of low-income DC residents dealing with often unjust, abusive, and illegal debt collection practices, as well as other consumer protection problems like credit reporting issues, identity theft, and predatory lending.”
- **Washington Lawyers’ Committee for Civil Rights and Urban Affairs** (www.washlaw.org), which “has been on the front line of civil rights work for more than 50 years.” The firm’s past Fellows have gained vast knowledge and experience needed to help to promote human rights, fight for consumer justice, and develop important policy initiatives.

During the remainder of the Fellowship, the Fellows will work side-by-side with the Firm’s attorneys on public interest litigation. Tycko & Zavareei LLP has a strong commitment to public interest work, and an active practice in areas such as consumer rights, employee rights, and whistleblower rights. The Fellows will be exposed to a wide variety of cases, and will be given substantial responsibility. The current salary for Fellows is \$80,000 for the first year and \$95,000 for the second year. The Fellows will be eligible to enroll in the Firm’s health insurance plan and Health Savings Account, will receive paid vacation and wellness time off, and may be eligible for bonuses.
